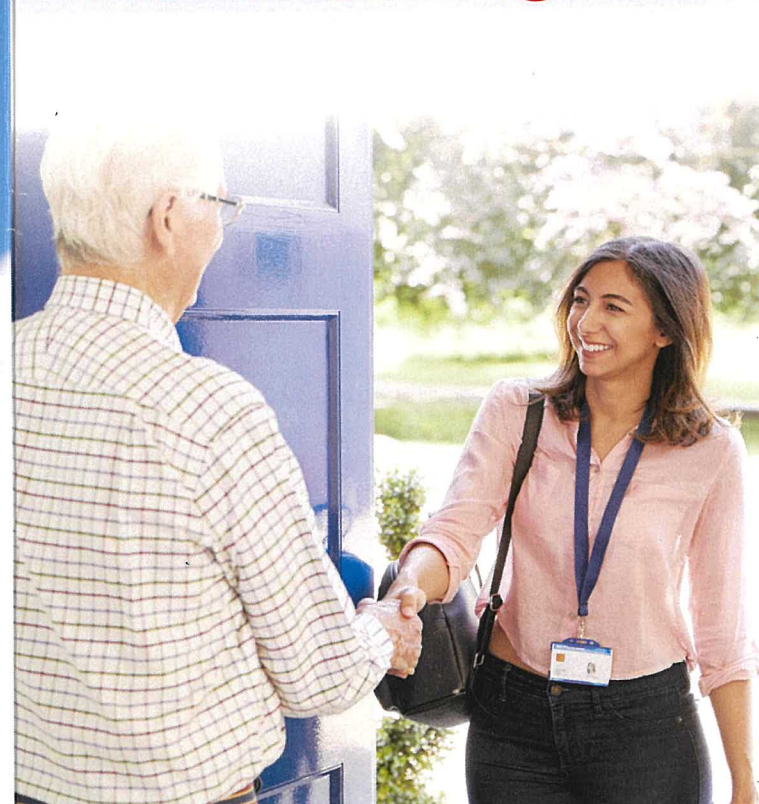

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About The Program

Monmouth Medical Center provides an unparalleled continuum of mental health services for our clients. The Community Prevention Program covers a vital part of this continuum by offering outreach appointments for all Monmouth county residents, both **children and adults**.

These services are provided at **no cost to the consumer**. We aim to prevent psychiatric crisis and costly emergency room visits by utilizing a proactive approach. Our goal is for clients to be equipped with an appropriate action plan that will lead them to mental health recovery.

Services can be requested by anyone- schools, private practitioners, community members or clients themselves. Simply call the crisis unit at Monmouth Medical Center at **732.923.6999** and ask for a preventative appointment. A clinician will ask some preliminary questions and a timely appointment will be scheduled. Upon arrival a needs assessment will be conducted by a psychiatric screener in the comfort of the client's own home. Additional specialists can be incorporated for substance abuse, family support, and peer support. An action plan will be individualized for each patient with linkage to services and referrals available. Follow up appointments are available as well.
