Applying for EOF Program Admission

Students must apply for admission by submitting the 2021-2022 EOF On-Line Admission Application that is available on the Brookdale Community College website. Click Admissions, click Educational Opportunity Fund, click Online EOF Admissions Application. In addition, a high school transcript must be submitted for review. Conditional admission may be granted as additional steps are taken to successfully enroll in the EOF program.

Meet with your guidance counselor and get details on Remote Live EOF New Student Information Sessions and seek assistance with applying for EOF program admission.

Academic Eligibility Criteria, Graduating High School Seniors

- Grade point Average of 2.50 or Higher on a 4.00 Scale OR the Equivalent of a 75 or Higher Average
- Students who do not have the minimum 2.50 or 75 average MUST provide a Personal Statement when submitting the EOF On-Line Admission Application

Financial Eligibility, 2021-2022 EOF Income Eligibility Scale

Students MUST be financially eligible for the EOF state grant of \$1,250 per school year. This is based on being income eligible- and submitting 2019 income verification documents.

Finalizing Program Enrollment

- Must submit by May 14, 2021, 2019 income verification documents. Income verification documents serve as proof of income to establish eligibility for our EOF state grant currently in the amount of \$1,250 and awarded each year based on full-time enrollment.
- Must File the Free Application Federal Student (FAFSA) or New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application and submit Confirmation page by May 14, 2021.
- Must complete or be waived from placement testing and be registered full-time Brookdale student for the Fall 2021 semester by June 1, 2021.
- Must attend an EOF Program Information Session & New Student Assembly, Dates to Arranged
- Must participate in the six -week Summer Bridge Academy, July 6- August 13, 2021 OR Be Waived from participation
- Must complete all Federal, Brookdale and state aid -related processing by July 30, 2021.
