

To Entering Students

State Law requires that all students must have either started or completed their immunization series prior to registering for school. If you are entering the Matawan Regional High School from an out- of - state or out- of - country school you will have a 30 day grace period to provide the district with either proof of your immunizations/serology or begin the vaccine series as required by state law. The immunization series must satisfy state law. If you are entering Matawan Regional High School from another school district within the state you must provide this district with a copy of your child's immunization upon registration. Your child cannot register without presenting a copy of their immunization records that can be obtained from your previous school district or your family physician. **If your child is born after January 1st, 1997 and entering into Matawan-Aberdeen School District your child must receive a booster dose of the Tdap and a dose of the Meningococcal vaccine if not already completed.**

A physical is required for **all** students that register for the Matawan-Aberdeen School District. This physical must be completed within one year of entrance date to the Matawan-Aberdeen School District or you must obtain a new physical within 30 days of registration. The universal physical form **cannot** be used as an Athletic physical form. The state requires a specific form. Please contact the nurse or Athletic Office if your child is going to participate in Athletics. Links for both physicals are provided on the web page for your convenience. **If your child is born after January 1st, 1997 and entering into Matawan-Aberdeen School District your child must receive a booster dose of the Tdap and a dose of the Meningococcal vaccine if not already obtained.**

If you are transferring in from another country you may require a **Mantoux or TB test**. If you are moving here from the following countries you **do not** have to obtain a Mantoux test. If your country is not listed you must have a Mantoux completed within the last six months or have it completed now.
