RE: Improper letting or taking of passengers/ Parking

Please be reminded that it is unsafe and unlawful to let children off or take on passengers (your children) in the middle of the roadway from your vehicle. At no times should you be stopping in the middle of any roadway while dropping your child off or picking them up from school. (39:4-65)

Once children are properly unloaded from your vehicle at the curb and not in a no parking/ no stopping or standing zone, the child should be reminded to cross at a crosswalk or preferably at an adult crossing guard. It is the pedestrian's responsibility to yield to vehicles if not in a crosswalk. (39:4-32f) Far too often are the children darting in between cars and crossing the roadway not only delaying traffic, but almost getting struck by vehicles.

Further, it is unlawful to park your vehicle in front or in a private driveway that you do not have permission from the homeowner to do so. Please be mindful and respectful to the neighbors of the school. Officers will be out enforcing traffic violations. Thank you for your continued cooperation in respect to the safety of the children in the Matawan Aberdeen School District.
