# Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying

***In order for an incident to be considered a HIB, it must meet the criteria of this legal definition:***

Harassment, intimidation, or bullying (HIB) means **any gesture, any written, verbal or physical act, or any electronic communication**, whether it be a single incident or a series of incidents that:

- is reasonably perceived as being **motivated by either any actual or perceived characteristic**, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, **or** a mental, physical or sensory disability; **or** by any other distinguishing characteristic
- **Takes place on school property, at any school-sponsored function, on a school bus, or off school grounds**
- substantially **disrupts or interferes** with the orderly operation of the school or the rights of other students
- Creates a **hostile educational environment** for the student

**If it does not meet this specific criteria, the incident will fall under the Code of Conduct and will still be addressed accordingly. Report it to your assistant principal and/or your guidance counselor in writing.**
